Thank you for the follow up.

We had the Leon County IT Department harvest any emails that were communications from or to Konnech. The total volume exceeded 13,658 emails. If we spend 227.6 hours at 1 minute per email to review and redact @ our current rate of \$25/hour, the bill would come to \$5,690.83 to fulfill the request.

The reason we need to spend time on the redaction is that since we were heavily involved in the creation of this software, going back to 2009, there are responsive records to your request that would reveal protected architectural software content and functionality that violate our security protocols to release. PollChief is strategically used by our office to plan, pack, store and deploy much of our election assets. As a CISA designated critical infrastructure sector (Elections is a Subsector of the Government Facilities Sector), we consider much of the requested content to fall under protected status.

There are other much easier and available content we can release with much less redaction time required, such as contracts, manuals and invoices.

We are eager to hear from you on how to proceed.

Also please be advised that I will be sending a copy of this communication to the legal team representing Konnech as they requested since your PRR was filed with us.
